# CAFETERIA MEAL PLAN

For Dormitory Students

2011-2012 School Year

The breakdown of the Cafeteria meal plan is provided below. 'Meal Plan Credit' is related to the actual consumption segment of the overall cafeteria fee. While the fixed overhead cost and meal plan credit is non-refundable, additional meal plan credit may be budgeted to accommodate individual appetites.

The student's account will be charged the non-refundable amounts at the beginning of each semester. Reconciliation will occur at the end of the semester and any consumption amount above the basic meal plan credit will be billed to the student's account at that time.

Statistics indicate that most of the students (50%+) require the budget for the additional meal plan credit. Some students consume more than the additional \$375/semester and a very small number (10%) consume less. If a student travels home for many weekends, if Grandma lives nearby and invites the student for dinner or if the student purchases meals at local restaurants, then the basic meal plan credit may be sufficient.

## **ACCESSING YOUR MEAL CARD**

The school ID card is personalized student identification used for campus meal plan purchases and is non-transferable. The bar code accesses your meal plan credit. Consequently, your ID card should be kept secure and handled with care. All lost ID cards must be reported to the Food Services Office immediately.

## **PURCHASING ADDITIONAL MEAL PLAN CREDIT**

If your meal plan credit runs out before the end of the semester, you may purchase additional meal plan credit at the Student Finance Office or by direct payment at the Food Services Office.

## **TRACKING YOUR MEAL PLAN CREDIT BALANCE**

Each time you make a purchase with your meal card, the cashier will be able to tell you how much you spent and what your new balance is. Please advise the cashier right away if you notice a discrepancy. You are in control of your own meal plan credit budget and have complete flexibility in menu selection.

## **PRICING: MAIN CAFETERIA DINING ROOM**

The price you will be paying for food purchases is at “cost” since the overhead costs are already included in the Basic Meal Plan package. You will be charged for take-out trays and all disposables as well as individually packaged condiments.

## **PRICING: CAMPUS SNACK SHOP**

The Campus Snack Shop will offer “snack” food, beverages and items such as French fries, corn dogs, chik’n nuggets, burgers and burritos. These items are sold to you at “regular retail” pricing. Some items will be GST applicable as per federal regulations.

## **FEEDING OTHERS**

You may feed others with your meal plan credit. However, please note this would reduce your meal plan credit significantly as all guests (including parents, siblings and other family members) will be charged “regular retail” prices.
