## Miscellaneous Scholarship Information

---



Parkview Adventist Academy believes in the value of scholarship dollars to enable and encourage students to pursue their academic studies. In addition to the Entrance and PAA Days Scholarships, a variety of other awards are available utilizing various criteria.

### **Alberta Resident Tuition Discount:**

- \$150.00 per semester of full-time attendance.
- Parent must reside in Alberta.

### **Adventist Constituent Dormitory Discount:**

- \$500.00 per semester of full-time attendance.
- Parent or student must be member of a Seventh-day Adventist congregation in BC, AB, SK or MB.

### **Family Discount:**

- In cases where two or more students come from one immediate family unit, the college will grant a discount of 5% on the cost of tuition per semester per student.

### **Matching Funds Scholarship:**

- Available to students from BC, AB, SK, MB.
- Eligibility is based on an assessment of family income. Families must apply for assistance through finance office.

### **Summer Community Service (July & August only):**

- Students may participate in community service during the months of July and August only and be eligible to receive a scholarship of \$125 / 25 hours of community service.  
*Non-profit organizations only; and remember that summer camps are ineligible.*
- Maximum award from any one or combination of "Summer" scholarships is \$1,000.

### **Summer Ministries:**

- Students who are paid by the Seventh-day Adventist Church (including CUC and PAA) for summer service may receive a scholarship equal to 30% of summer ministry earnings deposited on account by September 25 of the current school year with verification from the employer of the summer earnings.
- Maximum award from any one or combination of "Summer" scholarships is \$1000.

### **Additional information:**

- Total award amount will be divided equally between the two semesters of the school year.
- Recipient must attend for the Fall and Winter semesters to realize the full value of any award.
- The student must register for, and successfully complete, at least fifteen credits each semester **unless otherwise specified.**
