
Scholarship Information for New (N) and Returning (R) Students

Several programs for financial aid, scholarships, and allowances are available to qualifying students. These programs are funded by local conferences, Canadian University College/Parkview Adventist Academy and concerned and dedicated alumni and friends. Additionally, a recipient must register for, and successfully complete a minimum of 15 credits per semester. If the student withdraws from full-time study during the semester for any reason, the total award will be revoked for that semester. The value of all scholarships awarded for the 2008–2009 school year is divided in half and applied during the second month of each semester.

(N) Entrance:

- Scholarships are awarded at the graduation exercises of the various SDA junior academies in British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan, and Manitoba.

(N) (R) Family Discount:

- In cases where two or more students come from one immediate family unit, the high school will grant a discount of 5% on the cost of tuition per term.

(N) (R) Summer Community Service:

- Students may participate in community service during the months of July and August and be eligible to receive a scholarship of \$125 / 25 hours of community service (see Appendix 3).
- Maximum award from any one or combination of “Summer” scholarships is \$1,000.

(N) (R) Summer Ministries:

- Students who are paid by the Seventh-Day Adventist Church (including CUC and PAA) for summer service may receive a scholarship.
- The scholarship amount is equal to 30% of summer ministry earnings deposited on account by September 25/08 with verification from the employer of the 2008 summer earnings.
- Maximum award from any one or combination of “Summer” scholarships is \$1,000.

(N) (R) Three-Way Matching Scholarship:

- This scholarship is reserved for those students with extraordinary financial need. Students must apply for assistance through Parkview Adventist Academy (see Appendix 2).
- Eligibility is based on overall family financial need.
