

Purpose:

Who Does This Apply To?

This is a province wide policy

What's Expected:

Exceptions:

Medical conditions which need permission from a doctor. For specifc learning activities during class.

Social Media:

You won't be able to access social media sites on school Wi-Fi during school hours.

What Happens if You Break the Rules:

1st time: You'll get a verbal warning, and be reminded of the policy.
2nd time: Your device will be turned in to the office until
the end of the day, and your parents/guardians will be informed.
3rd time: Your device will be turned in to the office, and your
parents/guardians will need to meet with the Principal.
