PAA Cell Phone and Other Smart Devices Policy

Cell Phone and Other Smart Devices Policy

- 1. <u>Moderate cell phone/smart device use is allowed in the hallways</u>. However, remember that you're surrounded by people and that you should get to know them face-to-face;
- 2. <u>Store your cell phone in your locker</u>. Please make sure you lock them up to prevent loss or stolen items:
- 3. <u>Classrooms are a cell phone-free zone</u>. Please respect your teachers and others when they ask you to return your cell phone to your locker. Better yet, just lock it up before you come to class;
- 4. Consent should be obtained prior to photos being taken by/of other individuals. Some students have requested that their pictures refrain from any social media. It's their right!
- 5. Non-compliance to the above will result in a phone call home and further consequence should they be necessary. Let's just avoid getting to that point!


To create our desired learning environment, we are asking for your cooperation with these reasonable requests.
